The Fairfax Education Association (FEA) is pleased to announce the availability of the Joyce E Dawkins Memorial Scholarship

Established in 2013, this scholarship is named in memory of Joyce E Dawkins, a former Fairfax County Public School bus driver and supervisor. Joyce was instrumental in forming the Fairfax School Bus Drivers Association and was tireless advocate for the rights of bus drivers and attendants.

This scholarship shall be awarded to deserving students in the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuing a post-secondary education. Scholarship money will be used for expenses such as tuition, books or fees. Each year, there will be two scholarships awarded—one for the fall semester and one for the spring semester—in the amount of \$2,500 each. Application deadline for the spring semester is November 1 and for the fall semester is May 1.

To be eligible for the Joyce E Dawkins Memorial Scholarship, applicants must be a student whose parent, grandparent or legal guardian is either currently employed or was previously employed in the Fairfax County Public Schools pupil transportation field. An application, along with eligibility requirements and guidelines, is attached.

FACT SHEET

The recipient of the scholarship is a student who has a parent, grandparent or guardian either currently employed or formerly employed in the pupil transportation field in Fairfax County.

Selection of applicants will be based on the following:

- Scholarship: The student transcript will be evaluated by the committee. A student should have a 3.0 grade point average
- Leadership: The student shall have demonstrated outstanding leadership skills and abilities in cocurricular activities and community service activities
- Citizenship: The student shall have demonstrated exemplary citizenship qualities that include not only maturity, loyalty, responsibility, integrity and trustworthiness, but also a concern for the well-being of all citizens
- Service: The student shall have rendered unselfish service and assistance to others, to the school and to the community
- Essay: The student shall have explained in a typed essay, of not more than 500 words, why he/she applied for the scholarship and, if named the recipient, how the scholarship would be used

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION

Students who meet the general criteria will complete an application in which information supporting excellence in the five areas above will be noted. The application must be typed and contain all information requested. (Incomplete applications will not be considered.) Note: The essay and transcript <u>must</u> be submitted at the time of application. Applicants are encouraged to proofread their essays for spelling, grammar and syntax.

The application must be received in the FEA office <u>no later</u> than **November 1** for the spring semester and **May 1** for the fall semester.

The FEA Scholarship Committee will be responsible for selecting the scholarship recipient.

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
